The Industry Skills Package The Skills Warehouse – A Package of Skills

Casual workers (working less that 25 hours a week)

The Skills Warehouse Project – A Package of Skills offers jobseekers and the casually employed (working less than 25 hours a week) the opportunity to gain nationally recognised qualifications in the **warehousing and storage industry**. This Project is funded by Department of Employment & Industrial Relations' *Skilling Queenslanders for Work Initiative* and is **at no cost to eligible participants**.

This project offers you the opportunity to have your current skills recognised against units of competency from Certificates I and II in Transport and Logistics (Warehousing and Storage). If you need addition training we can provide 'gap' training where required.

Through the course you may have to opportunity to gain:

Units from TLI10107 Certificate I Transport and Logistics (Warehousing & Storage) such as:

AQF level I

- TLID107C Shift Materials Safety Using Manual Handling Methods
- TLID207C Shift a Load Using Manually-Operated Equipment
- TLIF107C Follow OH&S Procedures
- TLIG107C Work Effectively with Others

Units from – TLI20107 Certificate II in Transport and Logistics (Warehousing and Storage) such as:

AQF Level II

- TLIA1207C Pick and Process Orders
- TLIK307C Apply Keyboard Skills

The RPL (Recognition of Prior Learning) may involve gathering evidence to confirm your skills, this may be through an interview with yourself, looking at written references, speaking to previous or current employers or even demonstrating your skills at our warehouse training centre.

Forklift Training (30496QLD Course in Operating Load Shifting Equipment – OHSCER207A Operate a Forklift)

As well as units from warehousing you will also have the opportunity to undertake Forklift training. New licence requirements mean that you have to undertake a formal training course and then gain 40 hours log book experience, prior to being assessed and gaining a licence. This Skills Warehouse Project will include training, however we are unable to provide everyone with 40 hours experience. Where possible we will contribute to these hours through your experience in our simulated warehouse training venue. There are some eligibility requirements to gain a forklift licence so for more information contact Blueprint Staff.
