## The Skills Warehouse – A Package of Skills II

**The Skills Warehouse Project – A Package of Skills II** offers jobseekers the opportunity to gain nationally recognised qualifications in the **warehousing and storage industry**. This Project is funded by Department of Employment & Industrial Relations' *Skilling Queenslanders for Work Initiative* and is **at no cost to eligible participants**. Training is delivered in a warehouse environment – hands on and practical.

The course will cover manual handling, safe work practices in the warehousing industry and basic computer skills. The units have been selected to provide the basic entry levels skills required by most employers.

### Forklift Training

As well as warehouse training you will also have the opportunity to undertake Forklift training. New licence requirements mean that you have to undertake a formal training course and then gain 40 hours log book experience, prior to being assessed and gaining a licence This Skills Warehouse Project will include training, however we are unable to provide everyone with 40 hours experience. Where possible we will contribute to these hours through your experience in our simulated warehouse training venue. There are some eligibility requirements to gain a forklift licence so for more information contact Blueprint Staff.
